

2010-2011 INTERMEDIATE FENCING CLASSES



Congratulations! If you are receiving this, then you have achieved the "GOLD LEVEL" by passing the Beginner 2 test. The Three Rivers Fencing Center has developed the Intermediate Fencing Class to help students master the techniques and strategies of foil fencing, to learn the advanced rules and to prepare them for the next "BLACK LEVEL." Fencers may fence once per week (as per the Beginner Classes), or can fence two or more times per week during the Intermediate Practice times listed on the attached Daily Schedule. There is also no charge for fencing during Open Floor or Basic Skills class times, and students may schedule private lessons with our coaches at the TRFC Member rate. Students should attend at least two classes per week, but it is not a requirement. Fencers may use TRFC equipment, but are encouraged to purchase their own equipment (we can help select proper equipment). Passing beyond the "GOLD LEVEL" to the next "BLACK LEVEL" is by recommendation and invitation by the coaches. If selected, they will receive the coveted black patch worn by our most achieved fencers.
